THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWASSAN

By-Law 2002-23

Being a by-law to provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections in the Municipality of Powassan.

WHEREAS Section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H.8 as amended, provides that the Council of a municipality and the trustees of a police village may by by-law provide for the erection of stop signs at intersections on highways under its jurisdiction, and every sign to erected shall comply with the regulations of the Ministry:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan enacts as follows:

1. That the intersection on the highway set out in Column 1 is designated as an intersection where a stop sign shall be erected at the location shown in Column 2

Column 1

Catherine Street and Main Street

Column 2

Going west on Catherine St. and stop Before entering Main Street

Valley View East and Queen Street North

North on Queen -stop before entering Valleyview East.

- 2. That the penalties provided in Section 214 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
- 3. That each designation made by Section 1 shall not become effective until stop signs and yield signs have been erected in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.

READ A FIRST time and considered read a SECOND and THIRD time and passed as such in open Council this 2nd day of July, 2002.
