GUIDELINES FOR SEPARATING MATERIALS:

METAL RECYCLING

All items must be CLEAN OF FOOD and CONTAMINATES.

- Aluminum cans
- Pie and baking pans
- Tin cans
- Metal beverage cans

CARDBOARD RECYCLING

All boxes MUST BE FLATTENED for proper disposal.

- Corrugated cardboard, Shipping Boxes, Moving Boxes, Shoe boxes
- Cereal and dry food boxes
- Tissue boxes, Paper towel / Toilet tissue rolls
- Detergent boxes
- Soda/beer cartons

PAPER RECYCLING

- Newspapers, Computer Paper, Notebook Paper
- Inserts/Labels, Folders, Index Cards/Labels
- Magazines/Catalogs
- Paperback books
- Envelopes (with or without windows)
- Calendars
- Shredded Paper must be put in bags

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

One of the following symbols MUST be on the bottom of the container for it to be accepted for recycling)



WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED IN THE BLUE BOX?

- Styrofoam
- Window glass and mirrors
- Glass containers, bottles, etc.
- Propane Cylinder
- Electronic waste (TVs and computers, Ipads, tablets, electric cords, etc.)
- Motor oil containers/ Red Plastic gas tank
- Yard waste/ water Hose
- Chemical containers
- Plastic bags
- Ceramics or dishes
- Food waste
- Scrap metal
- Monitors
